

## North Central Chapter of the Health Physics Society Minutes of the Executive Council Meeting 21 April 2016 Rochester, MN

Attendees: Jan Braun, Lis Devin, Sam Hays, Mike Lewandowski

President-elect Jan Braun called the meeting to order at approximately 6:25 pm. The Council discussed the minutes from the Fall 2015 Executive Council meeting. Following the Fall Meeting, the Council reviewed and commented on the minutes by email. The Council officially approved the Fall Meeting minutes by unanimous approval and decided to review and approve future meeting minutes by email. The Council reviewed and approved new member applications. Two applicants (Jessica Gilles and Bindu Timilsina) are HPS members and are automatically approved. Craig Johnson's application was approved unanimously. Mike Lewandowski presented the Secretary/Treasurer's report. Membership is staying steady. About two-thirds of members have paid dues. That is about normal for this time of the year. Finances are good. This meeting's expenses are expected to be much less than from previous meetings so there is expected to be a net profit from the Spring Meeting. The Chapter's finances would support paying expenses or honoraria for speakers. This has been done in the past and resulted in well attended meetings. Lewandowski then reported on the Radiation Instrument Kit and the other science teacher and student outreach activities. The instrument kit remains well used. Some Chapter members attended a STEM career fair at New Brighton High School and Mounds View High School.

The Council paused to eat dinner and then resumed the meeting.

The Council reviewed the Affiliate Report submitted by Jesse Fillmore. There are 10 Affiliate Members. Four members will be exhibiting at the Spring Meeting. The representative for Canberra has changed from Andy McLain to Steven Mell. Sam Hays reported that he reviewed the web sites of other HPS Chapters. Most of the other Chapter web sites have not been updated in several years. Sam asked the Council for guidance regarding what changes he could make without express Council approval. The Council agreed that Sam has the authority to make changes in format and design to make the web site more active and engaging without prior approval from the Council.

The Council discussed that there is one candidate for the President-elect position and three candidates for the two Councilor position. Scott Huneycutt resigned his Councilor position because he is moving out of the Chapter. The Council discussed options and agreed to leave Scott's position open until the regular term begins at the Fall Meeting. The Council discussed approaching additional candidates at the Spring Meeting in an effort to finalize the slate of candidates and have the ballot prepared as quickly as possible.

Jan Braun reviewed the logistics for the Spring Meeting. Mike Lewandowski noted that the AAHP has granted 4 CECs for the Spring Meeting. Lis Devin graciously volunteered to write the meeting summary for HP News. The Council discussed incorporation. The sample articles of incorporation provided by the state of Minnesota are consistent with the existing Chapter Bylaws. Jan Braun agreed to serve as the registered agent for the Chapter. The Council members in attendance reviewed the incorporation document and signed the incorporation



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document. President Shari Mask and Councilor Jason Timm each signed a separate signature page for the incorporation document.

Potential locations discussed for the Fall Meeting were the University of Minnesota and Hamline University. Lis Devin will explore U of M locations. Jan Braun will talk to Jerry Artz about Hamline as a possibility. The Council discussed the use of hotels and other commercial venues for meeting locations as an alternative to a Chapter member's facility. The additional costs associated with catering and facility charges for commercial venues will influence the costs of future meetings.

There was no additional business for the Council to address.

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 8:45 pm.


